Rockville, MD – Delegate Alfred Carr, newly-appointed to serve out the term of the late Jane Lawton, honors her memory by continuing to award scholarships to students chosen in her name by The Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Educational Foundation Scholarship Committee. Also joining the MCPS Educational Foundation this year are Senator Jamie Raskin and Delegate Roger Manno.

These legislators join Senator Madaleno, Delegate Dumais, Delegate Feldman and Delegate Rice in having the Foundation Scholarship Committee seek out students with financial needs.

The MCPS Educational Foundation was established with the principle that no student should forego higher education for financial reasons. The Foundation most recently awarded over \$140,000 in delegation scholarships to financially needy MCPS students. In total, the Foundation will award over 150 scholarships this year.

"It is our dream to have no student in Montgomery County denied a higher education due to financial need," says Esther Gelman, chair of the Scholarship Committee.

The Foundation invites Montgomery County Public School seniors to apply for these scholarships which are primarily designated for Montgomery College's full tuition. If sufficient funds remain, the Scholarship Committee will use those funds for students applying to, or enrolled in, other Maryland institutions of higher education.
