Summer Bike Incentive

Various MCPS Title I Schools As an incentive for students in Grades Kindergarten through Grade 4 to attend two summer enrichment programs, as well as promote healthy lifestyles, we give away two bicycles (a male and a female bike) and helmets at each of the 25 program sites (50 bikes total). The Division of Title I and Early Childhood Programs and Services (DTECPS) will once again kick-off another summer of academic programming in Title I schools. These programs include Extended Learning Opportunities-Summer Adventures in Learning (ELO – SAIL) and Extended Learning Opportunities-Summer Title I Enrichment Programs (ELO – STEP). The programs are designed to increase student achievement and decrease summer learning loss while providing students with more than 150 additional hours of academic learning, at no cost. In addition, students receive free breakfast, lunch and transportation.
