Key Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant is MCPS employee
- Project & funds benefit MCPS community
- Project or related work not in regular MCPS budget
- Ability to use funds by June 30, 2024
- Project has single project lead
- Alignment with priorities in <u>MCPS Strategic Plan</u>, <u>Blueprint for Maryland's Future</u>, +/or <u>MCPS Antiracist</u> <u>System Audit</u>
- Funds will not be used for indirect costs; grant administration; lobbying; religious purposes; childcare*; staff stipends/salaries; consultant fees*; transportation costs*; recording/computer equipment*
