One Hundred Years Ago a small group of caring individuals shared the common beliefs held by the community that it is our duty to help those in need. The Social Services League was formed to provide relief to individuals and families living in poverty and to raise awareness of the root causes of such life crises. Our community has changed from rural and agrarian to urban and high tech, but the fact that poverty is still a critical problem has not faltered. Physical or mental illness, job loss, divorce, or catastrophe can plunge a person or family into crisis. It is our goal to continue the work started by our Founders and provide the support, encouragement, and hope that is needed more than ever.

In its early years the League expanded rapidly to include foster care, adoption, child advocacy, juvenile justice, and many forms of direct relief. In an effort to better reflect modern terminology and the expanded services, the League changed its name to the Family Services Agency in 1959, but the spirit never changed.

In 1959, Family Services won an award for championing the first community assistance program for the unemployed. In its recent history, the organization was the first in Maryland to undertake prevention of child abuse and neglect through the nationally recognized Healthy Families Montgomery (HFM) program. Other Family Service's firsts for the community include Early Head Start education and Montgomery Station, a pioneering program in psychiatric rehabilitation. The face of the organization changes, but the spirit lives on in each new program.

Continuing the Work...

Today, Family Services features an array of child and family support programs, as well as a wide range of mental health services. We employ a diverse workforce that reflects the needs of the community, placing emphasis on prevention and early intervention services. As long as there are people whose lives can be improved with support and collaborative programs, we will be here for them. We continue to evolve, adapting the programs and services we offer to address people's most critical needs.
